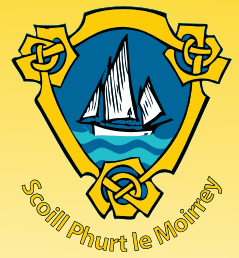

**Key skills: Hit the Button** - In addition, you can keep up with your tables, doubles, halves and many other number facts using [this site](#). You can set your own level of challenge and practice a range of skills.

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### Literacy

We will be focusing on consolidating some really important key skills. Each day you will have a different activity which will focus on helping you develop these key skills.

**Day 1:** Go to <https://www.literacyshed.com/wishgranter.html> where you will find a lovely video called '**The Wish Granter**'. Have you ever made a wish in a wishing well? Whilst watching have a think, what would you wish for and why? Choose one of the challenges that are at the bottom of the video and have a go at completing it. Rewatch the video as many times as you need to help you.

**Day 2: Identifying nouns phrases and expanded noun phrases** - Go to <https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/articles/zmqh2v4>. Watch the two short video clips which will explain expanded noun phrases. Once you have watched the videos, have a go at completing the three activities underneath.

**Day 3:** Go to <https://www.pobble365.com/> and look at the image for today. Look carefully at the image and think about what you notice and what questions you may have about this. Once you have done this, choose one of the activities that have been provided underneath the picture and have a go!

**Day 4: Identifying pronouns** - Today we are going to focus on pronouns. Go to <https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/articles/zjsnm39> and watch the short video clip about pronouns. How much have you learnt about pronouns? One you have watched the video, have a go and the activities below and check your learning by taking the quiz!

**Day 5: Big Write Challenge!** Today we would like you to have a go at completing a 'Big Write'. This piece of writing can be based on one of your own ideas or you can find some writing prompts to help you on this link: <http://www.scholastic.com/teachers/story-starters/writing-prompts/index.html>. For year 3 you will need to select '2nd Grade'.

**Day 6:** Go to <https://www.literacyshed.com/embarked.html> where you will find a lovely video called '**Embarked**'. How do you think Jimmy felt when he had to leave his special tree house? How would it make you feel? Do you have your own special place? Choose one of the challenges that are at the bottom of the video and have a go at completing it. Rewatch the video as many times as you need to help you.

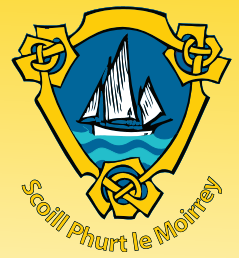

Watch the short video clip which will explain what verbs are and how they are used. Once you have watched the video, have a go at the activities below!

**Day 8:** Go to <https://www.pobble365.com/> and look at the image for today. Look carefully at the image and think about what you notice and what questions you may have about this. Once you have done this, have a go at answering the questions that have been provided underneath - the story starter might help you answer some of these questions. Once you have completed the questions, have a go at the 'Picture Perfect' challenge. The answers to your questions might help inspire you with this challenge!



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**Day 9: Identifying adverbs** - Go to <https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/articles/zbn492p> and watch the videos. How much have you learnt about adverbs? Once you have watched the videos, test your knowledge and try to complete the activities underneath.

**Day 10: Big Write Challenge!** Remember this piece of writing can be based on one of your own ideas or you can find some writing prompts to help you on this link: <http://www.scholastic.com/teachers/story-starters/writing-prompts/index.html>. For year 3 you will need to select '2nd Grade'.
